
PURPOSE



OUTLOOK


The information below indicates that the majority of Danville's key economic indicators are still lagging behind data from previous fiscal years. Even though the number of business licenses issued saw a positive spike in February, it continues to mirror other business related indicators that remain sluggish. Two bright spots in this data are that the sales tax collected continues to show growth over the previous three fiscal years and that new housing data shows a positive swing in the median sales price for Q3 of 2011. As the City continues to focus its efforts of economic development and revitalization, we can anticipate positive shifts for these indicators.




Fiscal Year: July through June




