
PURPOSE



OUTLOOK


Based on the information below, many of the key economic indicators for the city of Danville remain sluggish compared to previous fiscal years. Business related indicators, with the exception of the amount of sales tax collected, continue to fall behind previous years' data. As we embark upon a new year, there are glimmers of positive movement in some of the indicators. After months of lagging, the amount of machinery and tools tax collected is finally starting to catch up to the previous year's numbers. Also, the last two months of data shows that the unemployment rates for the city of Danville and its MSA have dropped by larger percentages than the rates for Virginia and the U.S. The list of economic development recruitment projects and local business expansion projects help us look forward to additional positive changes in 2012.






