## **City observes International Business Appreciation Day**

On February 12, 2025, in honor of International Business Appreciation Day, the Danville Office of Economic Development & Tourism (DOEDT) recognized the existing foreign industries in the Southern Virginia region, including nine companies located in Danville and Pittsylvania County. The City of Danville has celebrated this day of observance since 2013, when former mayor Sherman Saunders made the original proclamation.
